Do you know that a complaint form is available on our website? If you feel that one of Englewood Isles Property Owner's Association's Covenants is being violated, please use this form. It is located on our website, www.eipoa.org, under the Governing Documents tab at the bottom right of the page.

You must fill out your name and address, and the address where the violation occurs. The Board needs this to investigate and follow up with you. Your identity will be kept confidential. The bottom of the form has a simple math problem to complete to verify you are not a robot. Once the complaint is received, a Board member will contact you for more information, then follow up on the violation.

Service People

The Board has been advised of concerns that service people are parking in places other than where they are working. Please remind anyone working on your property to park in your driveway or on the street, not on a neighbor's property or on any grass, gravel or shell areas. Also, please try to contain any sprays used on landscaping to your property.

Architectural Committee Requirements

Please note that the Architectural Committee must approve ANY exterior changes to your property. **This includes new or repaired roofs, fences, walls, etc.** Windows, doors, and pavers do not require approval. 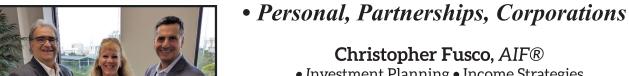

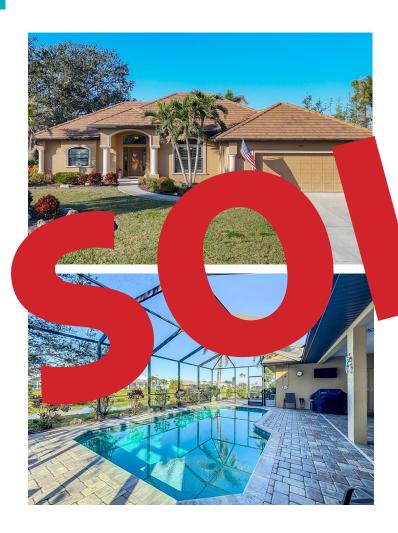

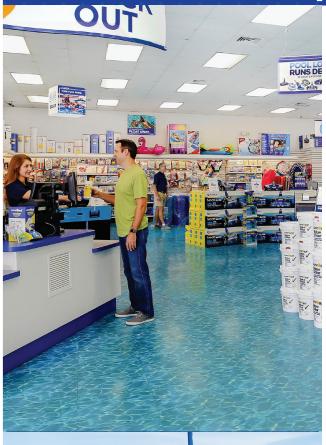
